

SMOKER'S "GOOD-WILL" CODE

This Code was developed as a positive response to the Tobacco Use Committee (TUC), by the Minority Rights Committee (MRC) in return for representation on the TUC, to help preserve the rights of smokers at Our Home and to help continue the friendship & camaraderie between smokers and non-smokers.

1. Respect Our Home Environment!

- Place your cigarette butts in an ashtray or smoking receptacle.
- Do not toss butts on grounds, in bushes or open areas.
- If walking or riding a scooter, do not discard your butts until you reach a receptacle or carry an appropriate container with you.
- Use receptacles in or near Bus Stops, Shelters and Benches. More receptacles are being added and better located

2. Educate other Smokers on our effort. "SPEAK UP".

- If you see someone improperly discarding a cigarette, tell them it's not appreciated. If they get offensive, report them to your Delegate. We don't need excuses. We need positive action.

3. Abide by the Rules!

- Never Smoke in any on-site building.
- Smoke only in designated areas.
- Never Smoke within 20 feet of any building (7 big steps)

4. Respect the Rights of Non-Smokers – We can get along!

- Never Smoke in Non-Smoking Areas.
- Never light up in their proximity if you know they are offended by it.
- Be courteous to Non-Smokers. They will appreciate it and hopefully, reciprocate.
